

# SENTIMENTAL ZEN

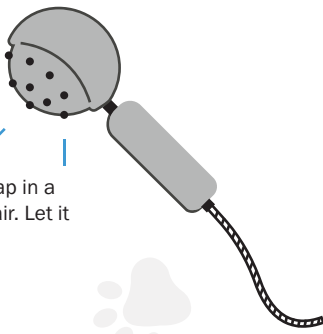
Take your dog with you in a new form, with this method! a hanger or would you rather have them right inside your pocket!

**Felting:** The process of producing a textile or fabric by combining and compressing the loose fibers, wool or hair.

Brush your dog and collect the hair in a bag.



Wash the hair with soap in a bowl to have clean hair. Let it dry.



## Tools



Felting needle \*



Foam piece  
(Sponge will work too)



Dog hair



Your hands



Razor

\* **DIY Needle:**  
If you don't have a felting needle make this instead.

## CAUTION



Do not stab your finger, it will hurt and cause injury.



Poke the hair on the foam until you get a firm bundle.



Shape the hair into basic objects with your fingers, repeat step 1 to make the shape firm.

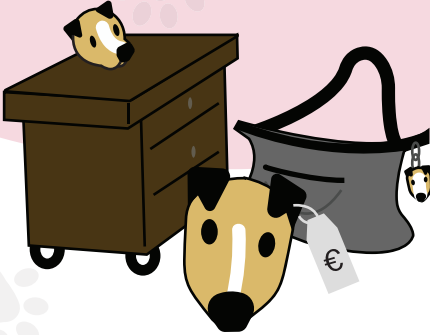


Combine the shapes and colour of your dogs hair (if possible) to create your desired item.



Use a razor to remove stray hair.

## Fashionable alternative method



Use a bowl with a little water for this method.



Spread your hair in small flat pieces.

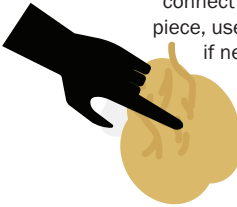


Rub the hair and the soap.

Use your needle if parts do not connect properly.



Ad small pieces of dry hair to thin parts or to connect a new piece, use soap if needed.



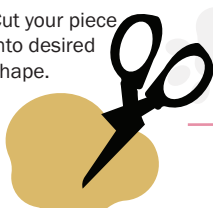
Rub the hair with both hands until it becomes firm, if needed devide the hair carefully.



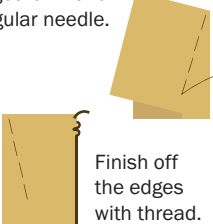
Let your firm piece dry on a towel when satisfied.



Cut your piece into desired shape.



Hand stitch pieces together with a regular needle.



Finish off the edges with thread.
